"But as for you, Daniel, conceal these words and seal up the scroll until the end of time. Many will go back and for the and search anxiously [through the scroll], and knowledge [of the purpose of God as revealed by His prophets] will [greatly] increase.""

I love prophecy. I know that is not the normal response of most people. Pulpits and Bible study classes tend to stay away from the prophetic scriptures. They make people nervous and unsettled. I have heard well known ministers sate that they did not teach or preach Revelation because they did not understand it. So how important is it for us to know?

"The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show His servants – things which must shortly take place. And He sent and signified it by His angel to His servant John, who bore witness to the word of God, and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, to all things that he saw. Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near." Revelation

The first thing, Revelation is the only book in the Bible that promises a blessing for those who read it or hear it and keep those things which are written in it. Second, we all need to be aware of these things because scripture tells us the time is near. Third, for me, this is a source of great comfort knowing that Jesus Himself spoke this Revelation for John to write down. But Revelation is the end of the story. To get the whole picture, you have to go back to the Old Testament and read the prophets, Daniel, Ezekiel, Jeremiah, and Isaiah who were instructed to give prophecies to God's
